Note from Our Lead Pastor

I was ordained on September 27, 1987. That was 438 months ago, or 438 monthly newsletter articles ago. This is my 185th newsletter article at Trinity. I'm sure I have skipped a few for special occasions over the course of the last 36 years, but it still feels like a lot of newsletters to write. I have to admit, as I come to this last one, I hardly know what to say. I know, that might not sound typical for me. But the truth is, there are many emotions and thoughts that run through my heart and mind these days and they are not always the most organized.

Consider how much I've said and written over the last 15+ years. You have heard me from the pulpit, the stage, in Bible Studies, letters, visits in your homes, at hospitals, funerals, weddings, and just having fun in social settings. You have heard me share serious, meaningful messages to help us all grow in our relationship with God. You have heard me share jokes (which you kindly laughed at on some occasions), and often, you've been in conversations with me just because the people of God hang out together sharing life with one another.

So, what message do I leave you with? It is this: Community. As individual Christians, we do have aspects of our faith that are private and personal. The Christian faith, however, is a community faith. God called the nation of Israel. Not just individuals. We are the Body of Christ, not just separate parts running around. We are a community. Trinity is a community, and within Trinity there are many parts of the whole community. (Are you in a Connection Group yet?)

Community means we live these words from Romans 12:15 together, "Rejoice with those who rejoice, weep with those who weep." We share life with each other. We do life together. We provide support, encouragement, and celebration. We are there for each other in the good times, the challenging times, the frustrating times, the empty times, the full times, all the time for whatever time is needed.

In the relationships of community, we grow together in our faith. We seek deeper understanding with God. We lift our praises in worship together, are fed by the pure Word of God, and the grace of the sacraments. We seek and hear the pronouncement of forgiveness, and we forgive one another gracefully and fully. (Remember Jesus' words, "If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven.")

One of God's great blessings to the Church (the Body of Christ) is that we are not alone. Together we have a bright future in the hands of God. He has promised to be with us always until the end of the age. And He provided community so that we would be in His presence and with each other. We hear that from His word, for "wherever two or three are gathered, there I am in the midst of them."

I have been blessed to be part of this community for almost 16 years. For each of us, community will be God-sustaining and God-supporting. Trinity's journey of faithfulness into the future will be guided by Him, as will mine. I will find community in my new Church and remain united with Body of Christ. Trinity's community will grow, become more united, and reach out to those hungering for the community we offer. Through the community of the whole Christian Church on earth, we remain united as believers in Jesus Christ, subjects of the kingdom of God, and brothers and sisters in the faith.



Note from Our Associate Pastor

THEREFORE, GO AND MAKE DISCIPLES OF ALL THE NATIONS, BAPTIZING THEM IN THE NAME OF THE FATHER AND THE SON AND THE HOLY SPIRIT. MATTHEW 28:19

Baptism is a sacrament which means a command of God. In the sacrament of baptism, God gives a promise for the forgiveness of sins. It includes God's word with an earthly element, water.

At Trinity Church, we believe in the importance of baptism for all ages. Among our body of believers you will find many who were baptized as infants and some not yet been baptized who, in obedience to the command of Jesus, desire to do so. In addition to these, there are some baptized as infants, who, as they have come to embrace their faith, want to affirm their baptism.

At Trinity Church, we sit in the space that is sometimes a little messy. We recognize that our church is filled with people of various denominational backgrounds and faith experiences. Respecting theological dissonance results in different preferences - including baptism.

Over the last few years, we have sought to better live out our theology and belief that all people be baptized. We agree that God is at work no mater the age or the means. We trust that, regardless of logistics, baptism will foster faith and faithfulness in Jesus.

Trinity offers three methods for those wishing to be baptized, whether first time or affirmation:

- 1. Affusion Pouring a little water on the head at font
- 2. Pouring Pouring a pitcher of water over a the head while in water tank
- 3. Immersion- The full body going underwater in a water tank

For the Lutheran asking if this aligns with Lutheran practice. This is very Lutheran! In fact, in the old green hymnals, one will find an Affirmation of Baptism liturgy service.

So what does this mean for you? If you haven't been baptized and would like to be, you are invited to do so. If you have been baptized, and want to affirm your baptism, you are invited to do so.

We look forward to celebrating the unity we have as followers of Christ in baptism. I'll close with a few verses to encourage us as we follow Him.

Acts 8:36-38 - And as they were going along the road they came to some water, and the eunuch said, "See, here is water! What prevents me from being baptized?" And he commanded the chariot to stop, and they both went down into the water, Philip and the eunuch, and he baptized him.

Acts 10:46-48 - Then Peter declared, "Can anyone withhold water for baptizing these people, who have received the Holy Spirit just as we have?" And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ.

GO VISION APPEAL UPDATE

It was about this time three years ago Trinity kicked off the Go Vision Appeal campaign to decrease our new facility mortgage debt. Thanks to your generosity, we've raised over \$1.06 million towards our goal of \$1.2 million. We are now just \$175,000 away from this initial milestone.

Alongside your donations, additional initiatives that have significantly reduced our mortgage are:

- Sale of Trinity Family Life Center on Lincoln Street
- Sale of our original Church Center on Halleck Street
- Sale of our excess property along 90th Street

Despite our successes, we still face a substantial mortgage debt of approximately \$4.65 million at an interest rate of 3.95% per year, resulting in monthly payments of about \$27,000, totaling \$324,000 per year.

Your continued support to the Go Vision Appeal is greatly appreciated. This fall we'll launch the next phase toward our debt reduction. Every contribution helps us reduce our debt, freeing up more funds for vital ministries.
