
I am excited for Pastor Mike Skunes to join us as part of Trinity Church and our staff team. He will be bringing a passion for the Gospel and sharing it with those both here at Trinity and those who do not yet know Jesus outside the walls of the church. Help welcome him and his family to Papillion and Trinity with an extra helping of Nebraska nice. Let us show him what "The Good Life" is all about!

With our 2025 Alive and Active theme, the whole church is invited to read through the Bible over the next year. We will read about three chapters a day, plus a Psalm. To get started, you will find resources available in the Commons and by email. For those who like to read online, link to the YouVersion plan, **One Story that Leads to Jesus**, which includes helpful videos and articles along the way. In your Connection Groups or in the Commons after worship, engage with one another about what you are learning. Our staff is also planning posts on social media and a podcast (watch for details) to help everyone stay engaged in the plan throughout the year. Join us in reading through the Bible this year. It's going to be great!

We are not far off from Ash Wednesday and the beginning of Lent. This 40-day Church season is a time of reflection and repentance in preparation for the celebration of Easter. It's a time to remember Jesus' death and resurrection, and to live a life more in line with His teachings. We will worship on Wednesdays through Lent at 6:00 p.m. beginning with Ash Wednesday on March 5th. This will be a traditional service the Holden Evening Prayer, liturgically sung and commonly used during Lent, along with a sermon and time for prayer. We look forward to these evenings for worship and reflection. Of note, we are not having Soup Suppers as they have not been well received the last several years.

During Lent, I invite you to the Rooted Experience. This six-week discipleship series will grow your faith as you discover the rhythms of a life with Jesus. In small-group settings, you will connect more fully to God, the Church and your purpose. While this series is required for our confirmation students and parents, **everyone is encouraged to participate**. I am looking forward to growing with you. 






From the Financial Team

All Fund: \$221,591.83 254 Donors 1 New Donors 109 Recurring Donors

General Fund Tithes and Offerings = \$156,725.95

Mortgage Fund Gifts = \$52,573.72



We finished 2024 with revenue exceeding expenses by \$90,000 and into 2025, our generosity toward the Here for Good (HFG) and General Fund campaigns continues to grow. Some encouraging stats include:

- 34 households who had pledged to our previous GO! campaign increased their HFG pledges by over \$200,000.
- 66 households who had not pledged to GO! did pledged to HFG for an increase of over \$300,000.
- 29 households (new or recently returned) plan to contribute over \$165,000 to HFG.
