

FROM THE ASSOCIATE PASTOR

It's a new year and we are a quarter of the way through the century!

As with the beginning of each year there is an opportunity to set new goals, new practices, and for many New Year's resolutions. While most resolutions don't last past a few weeks, the start of the new year is certainly a good time to start new things.

As a church, last year our theme was Different: Because of Jesus. Over the past 12 months we have learned that as followers of Jesus we are called to live differently in the world to impact how the world sees Christ. **This year's theme is, Alive and Active** based on Hebrews 4:12, "For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart."

During 2025, we will be encouraging everyone to intentionally create rhythms to be in God's word frequently and consistently. As the Word is Alive and Active, these practices bring transformation as we allow God's word to do what it does, change our hearts and minds in partnership with the Holy Spirit. The whole church is invited to participate reading through the entire bible in the year 2025. In February, we will launch the Bible Reading Plan, including a daily verse list, videos, articles, and an option to journal.

Sunday, January 12 is **Baptism Sunday** during the 10:30 a.m. worship service. We believe God is at work and moving in powerful ways at Trinity Church. Our response is to follow Jesus' command to be baptized. If you have not been baptized or you wish to reaffirm your baptism, we invite you to prayerfully consider this opportunity. At Trinity, we will baptize anyone of any age with any amount of water. Because of logistics for immersion baptisms, these are done on pre-scheduled Sundays. Greetings! My name is Mike Skunes (pronounced "Skoo-ness"), and I am currently one of the pastors at Christ Church in Mequon, WI, a little north of Milwaukee. My wife, Rachel, and I have called Wisconsin home for the last seven years while raising our two girls, Hannah (5) and Bethany (3).

While we have loved our time here in Milwaukee, at heart I am a Vikings fan lost in a sea of cheeseheads. I grew up in Mahtomedi, MN, just outside the Twin Cities, where I spent my high school days playing football, basketball, running track, and playing guitar in various garage bands. I stayed in Minnesota for college where I studied philosophy and political science at the University of Minnesota-Morris and would later return to Luther Seminary in St. Paul after seven years of full-time ministry.

I started in ministry as a bible camp counselor for four summers at Camp Wapo in Amery, WI, where I would eventually meet Rachel as a fellow counselor my second year there. My passion for sharing Jesus with youth led me to spending five years as the youth and family director for St. John's Lutheran Church in Northfield, MN, while Rachel taught elementary school music in a nearby public school.In 2017, I came to Christ Church, where I have served in various roles including youth director, worship leader, small groups coordinator, and missions pastor.

My passion in ministry is to see the incredible impact following Jesus makes in people's lives, especially for those who have walked away from church or didn't grow up going to church. I love helping the stories of scripture come alive in ways that allow people of every generation to connect their faith to their daily lives in real and relevant ways. As a former skeptic, I also deeply care about walking with people wrestling with questions, doubt, and loss, while trusting that the good news of Jesus makes a profound difference in this life and the next. As the Holy Spirit has pointed my family and I towards Trinity throughout this process, I am so encouraged by the prospect of being part of a community of believers with a passion for connecting people to Christ, caring for one another, and seeking to grow in ways that will make an eternal kingdom impact in Papillion and the greater Omaha area.

When I am not at church, you're likely to find me lifting weights in a CrossFit gym, cooking Mexican food, writing songs, fishing for bass, or taking my girls on a "worm hunt" after a good rainfall. I look forward to meeting and creating a future with you all.

FROM THE LEAD PASTOR CALL TEAM

After seven months of comprehensive interviews, careful deliberation and prayerful discernment, the Lead Pastor Call Committee has joyfully and unanimously recommended Pastor Mike Skunes to the Church Council for the position of Lead Pastor at Trinity Church.

Pastor Mike currently serves as associate pastor at Christ Church in Mequon, Wisconsin. Christ Church is an ELCA-affiliated Lutheran church in suburban Milwaukee that is similar to Trinity with multiple worship venues and both traditional and contemporary worship services. He has been at his current church for 7 years, serving as Ministry Director for youth, music and outreach. The past two years he moved to a pastoral call where his responsibilities include missions and connecting volunteers to mission partners. He is married to his wife of 12 years, Rachel, an elementary music teacher, and together they have two daughters ages 5 and 3.

Our committee's congregational forums revealed three primary criteria for Trinity's new lead pastor:

- 1. The current staff is doing a great job. Find a lead pastor who will guide and mentor the current staff and keep them at Trinity.
- 2. Find a lead pastor who is a good communicator and delivers biblically-based, scripturally-oriented messages.
- 3. Trinity's pastoral care could be improved. Find a lead pastor that is strong on caring for sick, terminally ill, homebound and grieving congregants.

Pastor Mike checks all three boxes and more. Our committee feels strongly that Pastor Mike will work smoothly with Pastor Matt and the rest of the staff here at Trinity. He is vibrant, energetic and personable. He has all the tools to be an excellent lead pastor and he comes to us from a church that is a "kindred spirit" to Trinity.

Our call committee is excited for the congregation to meet Pastor Mike and his family at the date and time currently being arranged by the Church Council. A 21-Day Challenge to Walk with Jesus

Hi Families!

I'm excited to share something special happening in our student ministry! At the end of our Elevate Retreat, I challenged students to participate in a 21-Day challenge called Rhythms. For 21 days, they will follow a daily guide filled with intentional practices to help them grow in their faith. The rhythms include three times of kneeling prayer a day, reading one chapter of John (since there are 21 chapters), reflecting on Psalm 23 daily, walking outside for 21 minutes without technology, and limiting social media and video games to 90 minutes a week.

You might be thinking, "There's no way students will do all that!" But I'm thrilled to share that many of them are fully embracing the challenge together. Would you join me in praying for them as they begin these rhythms to deepen their relationship with Jesus?



- By check: Use the memo to note the fund you want your gift applied. If nothing is noted, your gift will go to the General Fund.
- From Financial Institution: Please request a breakdown noted on the check.
- Through HDs: Request the breakdown for desired fund(s) to be noted.
