FROM THE CALL TEAM FOR LEAD PASTOR

The Senior Pastor Call Team hosted the first of three congregational forums on August 25th in the Chapel. The forums allow members to express to the call team what traits and qualities they want the team to consider in selecting a senior pastor to call. The first forum was well attended and many good inputs were received. There are two more opportunities to attend forums in September. The next opportunity will be during the second half of the Legacy Mornings gathering on Thursday, September 5th. Call team members will be in the Commons starting at 10 am to confer with the 55+ crowd. The second opportunity will be after services at 11:30 am on Sunday, September 8th also in the Chapel. We hope to also have online surveys for those unable to attend the forums.

Once the forums are complete, our team will start the process of setting up interviews with potential candidates. The team has received two nominations from the congregation for possible candidates to call. The names of the nominees have been forwarded to the Nebraska Synod of the ELCA for consideration. For confidentiality reasons, we cannot release the names of those candidates, but once the synod has vetted the candidates, we will set up interviews with them.

The call team will continue to accept your suggestions for possible candidates to call to be our next pastor. There are both paper and electronic forms available for the congregation to submit nominations. Receipt of this nomination form, however, does not guarantee an interview by our call team.

We are making a video of our church to attach to our Ministry Site Profile (MSP) which is visible on the ELCA's website. The purpose of the video is to show off our congregation and community in ways the MSP is not designed to. While this "recruiting" video is optional, we want to use it to help make Trinity Church stand out to candidates who may be considering multiple congregations. We need volunteers to be interviewed on camera about such topics as Papillion, our building, Trinity Students, Connection Groups, Raining Season, etc. If you are interested, see me or one of the call team members
